6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending Section 54-5-3 ACLA,
7 1949."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

9 Section 54-5-3 ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as
10 follows:

11 "Provided, that in cities of the first class the
12 primary responsibility for enforcement of all Alaska
13 territorial criminal law shall rest with the city police,
14 who are hereby classified as peace officers for Alaska.
15 United States Marshals and their deputies are not
16 authorized to enforce Alaska territorial criminal law in
17 cities of the first class as aforesaid, except when
18 directed by the Organic Act, a district judge, the
19 Governor of Alaska or when crimes are committed in their
20 presence. However, United States Marshals and their
21 deputies are authorized to cooperate at all times with
22 the Alaska Territorial Police and the aforesaid city
23 police in the apprehension of felons or suspected felons
24 and the investigation of felonies."
