HOUSE BILL NO. 12 BY REQUEST

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Territorial
Medical Board, and amending Section
35-3-82 ACLA 1949."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 35-3-82, Alaska Compiled Laws Anno-
tated, 1949, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 35-3-82 TERRITORIAL MEDICAL BOARD: QUALIFICATIONS,
APPOINTMENT AND TERMS OF MEMBERS: SUBSTITUTE MEMBERS. The
Governor of Alaska shall appoint a Board of Examiners, to
be known as the Territorial Medical Board, consisting of
Five (5) members, no more than two of whom shall reside
in the same Judicial Division, [TWO FROM THE FIRST DIVI-
SION AND ONE FROM EACH OF THE OTHER THREE DIVISIONS] who
shall be learned and skilled in the theory and practice
of medicine and surgery and shall be legal practitioners
of medicine and surgery in Alaska. Said members shall be
appointed for a term of four years and shall hold their
office until their successors are appointed and qualified.
In the event that a member is unavoidably prevented from
attending a regular meeting of the Board of Examiners,
the Governor is authorized to appoint a properly quali-
fied physician as substitute examiner to serve pro tem
and with the same duties and responsibilities as the
regular member, or unavoidably absent.
