BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The song, "Alaska's Flag", is hereby designated
10 the official song of the Territory of Alaska, being that music
11 composed by Eleanor Dusenbury, and the words written by Marie
12 Drake, as follows:
