HOUSE BILL NO. 66

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 44-2-14 ACLA 1949 as amended by subsection (1) of Section 2, Chapter 87, SLA 1949; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 44-2-14 ACLA 1949 as amended by subsection (1) of Section 2, Chapter 87, SLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) (Service requirements: Residence.) Persons who have served in the armed forces of the United States for (ONE YEAR) ninety days or more, or persons whose service shall have been less than (ONE YEAR) ninety days because of injury or disability incurred in line of duty, between September 16, 1940, and July 26, 1947, who have been separated from the armed forces with an honorable discharge or honorable separation, who at the time of induction into the service were residents of the Territory of Alaska, who had been residents for not less than one year immediately prior to their induction and who have returned to the Territory after discharge as residents with the intention of remaining in the Territory." (PROVIDED THAT NO PERSON WHO IS AN ENLISTEE OR RE-ENLISTEE SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A LOAN BY VIRTUE OF TIME SERVED AFTER NOVEMBER 1, 1945, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SAID ENLISTMENT OR REENLISTMENT WAS PRIOR OR SUBSEQUENT TO NOVEMBER 1, 1945.)"

1 Sec. 3. An emergency is hereby declared and this Act shall
2 take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
