HOUSE BILL NO. 103

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An act prohibiting the sale, serving, delivering, etc. of intoxicating liquor in licensed premises during certain hours of each day; prescribing penalties for violations; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any beverage dispensary, restaurant, road house, club or retail licensee, as those terms are defined in Section 35-4-21 ACMA 1949, to sell, deliver, offer for sale, serve, or allow to be sold, delivered, offered for sale, served or consumed, upon the licensed premises, any intoxicating liquor, or to permit the removal of any intoxicating liquor from such premises in any manner whatsoever, between the hours of two o'clock A.M. and six o'clock A.M. of each day; Provided, however, that any municipality, by ordinance duly enacted, may prohibit such acts for one continuous period longer than four hours each day, with the time of the beginning of such period to be before two o'clock A.M. and the time of the end of such period to be after six o'clock A.M.

Section 2. Any person who violates this act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$500.00, by imprisonment for a period not to exceed 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. In addition, any violation of this act shall be cause for the

revocation of the license for the sale of intoxicating liquor
of any such person.

Section 3. An emergency is declared to exist and this act
shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
