IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 61-14-10 ACLA 1949,  
and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 61-14-10 ACLA 1949 is amended to read as  
follows:

Upon the order being made, the executor or administrator  
shall sell the property therein specified upon the terms  
directed and in the manner herein otherwise provided. Such  
sale shall be made in the same manner as like property is  
sold on execution: Provided, however, The commissioner may,  
if thought best, order said property to be sold on the  
premises; Provided, however, that when said property shall be  
offered for sale as hereinabove provided and no bid or no  
acceptable bid is received, then the commissioner shall, upon  
application of the executor or administrator, direct that  
said property may be sold at a private sale. When the sale  
is upon credit the executor or administrator shall take the  
note of the purchaser for the purchase money, with a mortgage  
upon the property to secure the payment thereof.

Sec. 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this  
Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
