6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to repeal Chapter 134, Session
7 Laws of Alaska 1953; 'The Alaska Registra-
8 tion Law of 1953'; to reimburse certain
9 registrants thereunder for recording fees
10 paid; making an appropriation; and declar-
11 ing an effective period."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Chapter 134, Session Laws of Alaska, 1953, en-
14 titled "The Alaska Registration Law of 1953" is hereby repealed.

15 Sec. 2. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby directed to
16 pay to registrants of real property which on December 31, 1953
17 was within the then existing boundaries of any city, school dis-
18 trict, public utility district, or other taxing jurisdiction in
19 which on December 31, 1953 there was in force a tax on real pro-
20 perty, an amount equal to recording fees paid by said registrants
21 for registering their then owned and so situate real property in
22 the office of any United States Recorder under provisions of
23 Chapter 134, Session Laws of Alaska 1953; Provided, however,
24 that such payment or payments shall be made only on application
25 therefor presented to the Territorial Treasurer by the registrant
26 applicant which application shall, before its presentation to
27 the Treasurer, have been verified as to amount and payment of
28 such recording fee or fees by the United States Recorder for the
29 recording precinct in which such property registration was

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recorded.

Sec. 3. The Territorial Treasurer shall prepare application and verification forms for the purposes hereof, and distribute the same on request to individuals, associations, corporations and United States Commissioners.

Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$ _____ for the purposes hereof, and the Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized to voucher against said appropriation in making the payments herein authorized, for printing the forms herein directed, and for the hiring of any personnel by him deemed necessary for the performance of said duties.

Sec. 5. This Act shall be in full force and effect until December 31, 1956, at which time the authority herein conferred shall terminate and any balance remaining in the appropriation made in Section 4 hereof shall revert to the General Fund in the Territorial Treasury; Provided, however, that any duly verified application which is received in the Territorial Treasurer's office in an envelope which bears a postmark not later than December 31, 1956, shall be deemed to have been received by December 31, 1956 and, if not otherwise disqualified, shall qualify for the payment hereinabove provided.
