HOUSE BILL NO. 174

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An act to provide for the recovery of
civil damages from a parent ^{or guardian} due to the
malicious or wilful destruction of prop-
erty by minors."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Civil liability of parent: Penalties. Any
person, individual, partnership, municipal corporation, private
corporation, association, village, school district or any reli-
gious or charitable organization, whether incorporated or ^{un-}incor-
porated, shall be entitled to recover damages in a civil action
in an amount not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and
court costs, in a court of competent jurisdiction, from either
parent or both parents of any ^{minor} under the age of 18 years
who shall maliciously or wilfully destroy property, real, personal
or mixed, belonging to such person, individual, partnership,
municipal corporation, private corporation, association, village,
school district or any religious or charitable organization,
whether incorporated or unincorporated.
