HOUSE BILL NO. *123*

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA  
TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to municipal construction and maintenance of roads, trails, parks and playgrounds outside of municipal boundaries; amending subsection Fifth (A) of Section 16-1-35, ACLA, 1949; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsection Fifth (A) of Section 16-1-35 ACLA 1949 is amended to read as follows:

Fifth (A) (Roads and trails outside city: Parks and playgrounds.) To provide for the location and construction, for a limited extent, of trails and roads outside the limits of a city, but leading to and from the same, where such roads and trails are necessary for promoting the welfare and prosperity of the city; and also to provide for the location, construction and maintenance of parks AND playgrounds and recreation areas either within the corporate limits of the city or outside the limits of a city WITHIN FIVE MILES OF THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES THEREOF; but, no money shall be expended for such purposes except upon <sup>majority</sup> the unanimous vote of the entire council unless the qualified voters of the town, at an annual or a special election, by a <sup>majority</sup> two thirds vote of all those voting on the proposition have declared in favor of such expenditures.

p. 1, line 27: strike the words "two thirds" and insert word "majority"

1           Sec. 2. An emergency is declared to exist and this Act shall  
2 take effect immediately upon its passage and approval, or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
