HOUSE BILL NO. 133

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An act relating to the submission of school budgets to the city council in city school districts; and amending Section 37-3-35 ACLA 1949; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 37-3-35 ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 37-3-35. SUBMISSION OF BUDGET TO COUNCIL: DETERMINATION OF AMOUNT TO BE MADE AVAILABLE: ORDER FOR PAYMENT TO SCHOOL BOARD TREASURER: TAX LEVY. As soon as a city school board shall be organized after the annual election it shall estimate the amount of money necessary for school purposes for the ensuing school year and submit such budget to the city council. The city council shall then determine the amount of money to be made available for school purposes, provided that the said city council shall not reduce the amount set forth in the school budget if the budgetary request does not exceed the amount of taxes which can be raised by a ten (10) mill levy on the assessed valuation of all real and personal property within the city. (AND) The city council shall furnish the school board of the city a statement of such sum, and shall require the treasurer to pay the sum

to be made available for school purposes to the treasurer
of the school board (.) , provided that payments shall
be made at least once each three months and that each
such payment shall not be less than one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) of
the total amount to be made available. The amount of
money to be made available by the municipality for school
purposes shall be determined by resolution of the council
before the tax levy is made, and such amount may be levied
as a separate tax or as a part of the municipal tax.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and
this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and
approval.
