HOUSE BILL NO. 134

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the term of office of school board members; repealing Section 37-3-49 ACLA 1949 and substituting a new section therefor; and providing an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 37-3-49 ACLA 1949 is hereby repealed and there is substituted therefor a new section to read as follows:

Section 37-3-49. TERM OF OFFICE OF SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS: The term of office of the school board members of an independent school district shall be three (3) years, provided that for any independent school district already organized the term of the present members shall continue to their expiration dates. For a newly incorporated independent school district board the five members initially elected shall immediately after qualifying as board members assemble and shall by lot draw numbers 1, 2, and 3. There shall be drawn two (2) number 3's, two (2) number 2's, and one (1) number 1. The member drawing number one (1) shall serve until the first school board election following as provided by law at which term his successor shall be elected and qualified for a three-year term. The members drawing number two (2) shall serve until the second school board election following as provided by law at which time their

successors shall be elected and qualified for three-year terms. The members drawing number three (3) shall serve until the third school board election following as provided by law at which time their successors shall be elected and and qualified.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval and passage according to law.
