6 For an Act entitled: "An Act defining the crime of aggravated
7 assault; prescribing penalties; declaring
8 an emergency."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Every person who--

11 (1) with intent to injure, unlawfully administers to,
12 or causes to be taken by another, poison or any other des-
13 tructive or noxious thing, or any drug or medicine, the use
14 of which is dangerous to life or health; or

15 (2) with intent thereby to enable or assist himself or
16 any other person to commit any crime, administers to, or
17 causes to be taken by, another, chloroform, ether, laudanum
18 or any other intoxicating narcotic or anesthetic; or

19 (3) wilfully inflicts grievous bodily harm upon another
20 with or without a weapon; or

21 (4) wilfully assaults another with a weapon or other
22 instrument or thing likely to produce bodily harm; or

23 (5) being armed with a deadly weapon, wilfully assaults
24 another with a whip; or

25 (6) assaults another with intent to commit a felony or
26 to prevent or resist the execution of a lawful process or
27 mandate of any court officer, or the lawful apprehension or
28 detention of himself or another person; or

29 (7) drives any automobile, motorcycle or other motor

vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquors
or narcotic drugs, or drives in a careless, heedless manner,
in wilful or wanton disregard of the rights or safety of
another, and inflicts injury upon another person; or

(8) while hunting any game, or other animals or birds,
shoots another;

shall be guilty of aggravated assault and be punished by a fine
of not more than One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars or imprison-
ment in a penitentiary for not more than five (5) years nor less
than one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this
Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
