6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending 65-5-41 ACLA 1949, per-
7 taining to larceny; and declaring an
8 emergency."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Section 65-5-41 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to
11 read as follows:

12 Sec. 65-5-41. Larceny of money, etc.: Description in
13 indictment. That if any person shall steal any money, goods,
14 or chattels, or any Government note, or bank note, promis-
15 sory note, or bill of exchange, bond, or other thing in
16 action, or any book of accounts, order, or certificate,
17 concerning money or goods, due or to become due or to be
18 delivered, or any deed or writing containing a conveyance of
19 land or any interest therein, or any bill of sale, or
20 writing containing a conveyance of goods or chattels or any
21 interest therein, or any other valuable contract in force,
22 or any receipt, release, or defeasance, or any writ, pro-
23 cess, or public record, the property of another, such per-
24 son shall be deemed guilty of larceny, and upon conviction
25 thereof, if the property stolen shall exceed in value
26 [THIRTY-FIVE] one hundred dollars, shall be punished by
27 imprisonment in the penitentiary not less than one nor more
28 than ten years; but if the property stolen shall not exceed
29 the value of [THIRTY-FIVE] one hundred dollars, such

1 person, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprison-
2 ment in the county jail not less than one month nor more than
3 one year, or by fine not less than twenty-five nor more than
4 one hundred dollars; Provided, That in all prosecutions for the
5 larceny of money wherein an exact description of the number and
6 denomination of the coin or other money taken cannot be given,
7 it shall be sufficient to allege that the same was lawful money
8 of the United States, or of any other country or countries as
9 the case may be, and the value thereof in money of the United
10 States.

11 Sec. 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this
12 Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
