HOUSE BILL NO. 151

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act defining the crime of conspiracy; prescribing penalties; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. WHAT CONSTITUTES CONSPIRACY.

Whenever two or more persons conspire--

(1) to commit a crime; or

(2) falsely and maliciously to procure another to be arrested or proceeded against for a crime; or

(3) falsely to institute or maintain any action or proceeding; or

(4) to cheat or defraud another out of any property by unlawful or fraudulent means; or

(5) to prevent another from exercising any lawful trade or calling or from doing any other lawful act, by force, threats, or intimidation, or by intervening or threatening to interfere with any tools, implements or property belonging to or used by another, or with the use or employment thereof; or

(6) to commit any act injurious to the public health, public morals, trade or commerce, or for the perversion or corruption of public justice or the due administration of the law; or

(7) to accomplish any criminal or unlawful purpose, or

to accomplish a purpose, not in itself original or unlawful,
by original or unlawful means
every such person shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. OVERT ACT NOT NECESSARY.

In any proceeding for violation of Section 1 hereof,
it shall not be necessary to prove that any overt act was done
in pursuance of such unlawful conspiracy or combination.

Sec. 3. EMERGENCY.

An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
