HOUSE BILL NO. *127*

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act Prohibiting Fish Traps on
Lands owned by the Territory of
Alaska; providing for restrictive
covenants in the sale or lease of
such lands; defining violations;
prescribing penalties; and declar-
ing an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. It shall be unlawfull to erect, ^{upset,} maintain,
or operate floating, pile driven, or hand driven fish traps
on or over any lands owned ^{or leased by the Territory} by the Territory of Alaska.

Section 2. The lease or sale of any ^{such} Territorial lands
shall contain a restrictive covenant in keeping with the
intent of this act.

Section 3. A violation of this act shall be a mis-
demeanor and shall be punishable by imprisonment in the
Federal jail not to exceed six months or by fine not to
exceed \$1000.00 or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. If any provisions of this Act, or the
application thereof to any person or circumstances is held
invalid, the remainder of the Act and such application to
persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist
and this Act shall take effect immediately upon passage.
