A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Sec. 36-2-3, ACLA, 1949,
by adding a provision permitting an agent
for service of process to resign and for
filing of such resignation."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 36-2-3, ACLA 1949, is hereby amended by
adding thereto the following provision: An agent designated by
either a foreign or domestic business corporation for the service
of process may file with the Auditor for Alaska (ex officio Cor-
poration Commissioner) and with the Clerk of the District Court of
each Judicial Division wherein such corporation is engaged in
business a written, signed statement of resignation, which shall
be either verified or acknowledged by such agent. Upon the termin-
ation of 60 days after such filing the authority of the agent shall
cease. Upon such filing the Auditor for Alaska (ex officio Cor-
poration Commissioner) shall forthwith mail a copy of such resig-
nation to the corporation at its principal office as shown upon
the records of his office. A fee of \$5 shall be paid to the
Territorial Auditor (ex officio Corporation Commissioner) for the
filing of such statement of resignation.
