HOUSE BILL NO. 167

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting the employment by the Territory of Alaska of any person related to the executive officer of a Territorial Department, Bureau or Agency; prohibiting the simultaneous employment of husband and wife; prescribing penalties, and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. DECLARATION OF INTENT.

Whereas the executive officers of Territorial Departments, Bureaus and Agencies receive salaries which are determined or limited by the Legislature; and

Whereas it is the wish and desire of the Legislative branch of the Territorial Government that the monies exacted and to be exacted from the people of Alaska by taxation be expended in a manner best calculated to directly benefit the greatest number of Alaskans, NOW THEREFORE: it is the intent and purpose of the Legislature by this enactment to limit employment by the Territory of Alaska within immediate families to one member, to prohibit employment of husbands and wife, school teachers and public health personnel alone excepted, and to prohibit the practice of nepotism within the Territorial Government.

Section 2. No appointee to or employee of any Territorial Department, Bureau or Agency shall be related by blood or mar-

1 rise to the executive head of any Territorial Department,  
2 Bureau or Agency or to the assistant to any such executive.

3 Section 3. No husband and wife shall be simultaneously  
4 employed by the Territory of Alaska, professionally qualified  
5 school teachers, and public health personnel alone excepted.

6 Section 4. Any person who appoints or employs another and  
7 any person who accepts employment in violation of the provisions  
8 of Sections Two and Three hereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor  
9 and shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred  
10 (\$500.00) Dollars.

11 Section 5. Any officer or employee of Alaska who disburses  
12 any public funds or fees under his control, or who authorizes the  
13 granting of a warrant or authority for the disbursement of any public  
14 funds or fees as salary, pay or compensation of any person who  
15 shall violate the provisions of this Act shall be guilty of a  
16 misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than  
17 Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.

18 Section 6. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and  
19 this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and  
20 approval, or upon its becoming law without such approval.
