IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to examination of city
police officers; ~~repealing~~ ^{repealing} Section 16-1-72
ACLA 1949; and setting an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 16-1-72 ACLA 1949 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. Effective Date: This Act shall be in effect on
and after its passage and approval, or upon its becoming law with-
out such approval.

Page 1, Line 10: Strike Section 1 and insert new Section 1 as follows:

"Section 1. Section 16-1-72 ACLA 1949 is amended to read as follows:

Section 16-1-72. _____ Conduct of examination: Grading and determining results: Filing and inspection of papers. The examination shall be conducted under the supervision of the /MAYOR/ police chief upon written questions prepared /BY THE MAYOR OR AT/ under the direction of the police chief and the city attorney. The answers thereto shall be graded by the /COMMON COUNCIL/ police chief who shall /HAVE THE SOLE POWER TO/ determine whether an applicant has passed or failed, subject to review by the Mayor and Council in their discretion. The questions and answers shall be filed with the clerk of the city for permanent safekeeping and shall be open to inspection by the public.
