6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section ⁵¹ 5-2-11 ACLA 1949,
7 pertaining to the Board of Trustees of
8 the Pioneers' Home."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Section ⁵² 5-2-11, Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated,
11 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 Sec. ⁵¹ 5-2-11. (b) Board of Trustees: Control: Mem-
13 bers. Such institution shall be under the control and mana-
14 gement of a board of THREE ~~five~~ members, one of whom shall
15 be a woman and one of whom shall be from the Second ^{or} and
16 Fourth Judicial Divisions, to be known as the Board of
17 Trustees of Alaska Pioneers' Home. The members of said
18 Board of Trustees are to be appointed by the Governor sub-
19 ject to confirmation of the Senate and House of Representa-
20 tives. The term of office of the members shall be three
21 years, except as herein after provided. At their first meet-
22 ing they shall divide themselves into three classes. The
23 term of the member of the first class shall expire at the
24 end of the first year; the term of the member of the second
25 class at the end of the second year; the term of the member
26 of the third class at the end of the third year; so that
27 ~~one new member~~ may be appointed at the end of each year.
28 If a vacancy should occur during a term, the Governor may
29 appoint someone to serve during the balance of the unex-
