6 For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to the purchase of  
7 intoxicating liquor by minors; amending  
8 Section 35-4-15 AGLA, 1949, *as amended by 36 S.A. 1953*

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 35-4-15 AGLA, 1949, *as amended by 52A 1953* is hereby amended by adding at  
11 the end thereof new subsections designated by the numbers 10,  
12 11, 12, 13 and 14 which reads as follows:

13 Sec. 10. Any person who influences or attempts to in-  
14 fluence the sale, giving, or serving of intoxicating liquor,  
15 including beer and wine, to a person under twenty-one years  
16 of age, by misrepresenting the age of such person, or who  
17 shall order, request, receive, or procure intoxicating  
18 liquor from any licensee, employee, or other person, for the  
19 purpose of selling, giving, or serving the same to a person  
20 under twenty-one years of age, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

21 Sec. 11. Any person under the age of twenty-one years  
22 who shall enter any licensed premise where intoxicating  
23 liquor is sold, not in the company of his or her parent or  
24 legal guardian, or who shall offer or present to any licensee,  
25 employee, or other person a fraudulent or false certificate  
26 of birth or other written evidence of age, which is not ac-  
27 tually his or her own, or who shall otherwise misrepresent  
28 his or her age, for the purpose of inducing the licensee or  
29 employee, or other person to sell, give, serve, or furnish

1           intoxicating liquor contrary to law, is guilty of a misde-  
2           meanor.

3           Sec. 12. Any licensee, employee, or other person who  
4           questions, or has reason to question, whether a person en-  
5           tering upon a licensed premise, or ordering, purchasing,  
6           attempting to purchase or otherwise procuring or attempting  
7           to procure the serving or delivery of intoxicating liquor,  
8           has attained the age of twenty-one years, shall require such  
9           person to sign a statement that he or she is over the age  
10          of twenty-one years. Said statement shall be made upon a  
11          form to be prepared by and furnished to the licensee, employ-  
12          ee, or other person by the Territorial Tax Commissioner.

13          Sec. 13. Any licensee, employee, or other person who  
14          allows to remain upon a licensed premise where intoxicating  
15          liquors are sold, not in company of his or her parent or  
16          legal guardian, or sells, gives, or serves intoxicating  
17          liquor to any person under the age of twenty-one years, with-  
18          out having procured the signature of said person upon a  
19          statement as herein provided, or who knowingly sells, gives,  
20          or serves intoxicating liquor to or allows said person to  
21          remain on a licensed premise where intoxicating liquor is  
22          sold, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

23          Sec. 14. Any person violating any provision of this  
24          Act, or any provision of the law of Alaska pertaining to  
25          intoxicating liquor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and  
26          upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment of  
27          not more than one year or by a fine of not more than \$500.00,  
28          <sup>each</sup> each violation to be considered a separate offense, as  
29          follows:

2. 2, line 27: after \$500.00, insert: change comma to period  
"When the violation involves a licensed premises  
in addition to all other penalties that may be  
imposed by this Act, the following punishment may  
be also imposed,"

0 First Violation: The license of the premises involved  
1 may be suspended for not <sup>less than ten nor</sup> more than forty-five (45) days;

2 Second Violation: The license of the premises involved  
3 may be suspended for a period of not <sup>less than 30 nor</sup> more than ninety (90)  
4 days;

5 Third Violation: The license may be cancelled; the bond  
6 may be forfeited.
