7 OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED
8 STATES AND TO THE HONORABLE DOUGLAS MCKAY, SECRETARY OF THE
9 INTERIOR:

10 Your memorialist, the House of Representatives of
11 the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-Second
12 Regular Session assembled, respectfully submits that;

13 WHEREAS, under the law of the United States the States
14 therein receive the benefit of ninety percent of the profits
15 from the base of coal and certain other mineral lands therein;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the Territory of Alaska is discriminated
18 against in the benefit of profits from these mineral lands
19 under existing Federal Law; and

20 WHEREAS, House Resolution 247, a bill to correct this
21 discrimination now existing is pending before the Congress of
22 the United States,

23 NOW, THEREFORE, your memorialist, the Legislature of
24 the Territory of Alaska urges that this Legislation be passed
25 and approved, thereby eliminating this unfair discrimination.
