11 TO THE TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY ENGINEER:

12 YOUR MEMORIALIST, the House of Representatives of the  
13 Legislature of Alaska, respectfully represents:

14 WHEREAS, the Cache Creek road, connecting Talkeetna,  
15 Alaska, with the Cache Creek mining area is in a serious state  
16 of disrepair, and

17 WHEREAS, the future of the mining industry in this area as  
18 well as the welfare of the people, being several hundred in  
19 number entirely dependent upon mining for a livelihood, is in  
20 jeopardy as a result of this serious condition, and

21 WHEREAS, the Talkeetna mining district has for a period of  
22 many years generously contributed in the way of taxation to the  
23 Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, and

24 WHEREAS, this requested investment in road rehabilitation  
25 will be more than returned to the Treasury in the preservation  
26 of industry and safeguard of welfare,

27 THEREFORE, we direct that you expend such sums as are  
28 necessary to rehabilitate the Cache Creek Road its full length,  
29 and further direct that you commence such program in the early  
30 spring of 1955 as soon as is practical.
