6 NATURALIZED AT ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, FEBRUARY 17, 1955.

7 YOUR MEMORIALIST, the House of Representatives of the  
8 Alaska Legislature in Twenty-second Session assembled, respect-  
9 fully submits that:

10 WHEREAS, your obligation taken at the time of your natur-  
11 alization imposed upon you all the responsibilities of the  
12 citizens of the United States of America; and

13 WHEREAS, you also acquired certain liberties, freedoms,  
14 rights and guarantees as were fully set forth in the Constitution  
15 of the United States of America; and

16 WHEREAS, the enactment of the laws of our country is the  
17 responsibility of the elected members of our Legislature and  
18 the execution or enforcement of said laws reposes in the  
19 elected officials of our country and Territory; and

20 WHEREAS, the Courts have a most important duty to safe-  
21 guard the rights, liberties, freedoms and constitutional  
22 guarantees of all our citizens, regardless of color, creed or  
23 political affiliation;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the House of Represent-  
25 atives of the Legislature of Alaska, in Twenty-second Regular  
26 Session assembled, respectfully urges that our newly obligated  
27 citizens become fully aware of the great importance of the  
28 Courts in guarding the liberties of the people of our Country  
29 and the Territory of Alaska, and that they be especially careful
