1 IN THE HOUSE

2 HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 2

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TERRITORY  
6 OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS, the fishing village of Kake, Alaska, does not  
8 have an adequate boat harbor and must rely on the harbor at  
9 Portage for protection, which is about three-fourths mile  
10 distant, and

11 WHEREAS, the only industry offering employment in the  
12 Kake area is situated at Portage, and

13 WHEREAS, only an improved trail exists between Kake and  
14 Portage which was constructed on a volunteer basis by Kake  
15 residents to the limit of their ability with the equipment  
16 available, leaving it only partly passable for auto traffic,  
17 and

18 WHEREAS, Kake, with its population of about 350, has  
19 contributed generously to the Territorial Treasurer in the form  
20 of taxes; and said area, if developed, assures return of even  
21 larger revenues to the Territory;

22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
23 directs the Territorial Highway Engineer to proceed  
24 with the improvement and construction of a suitable road between  
25 Kake and Portage, Alaska, a distance of about three-fourths  
26 mile to begin as soon as possible.
