4 TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TERRITORY
6 OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS, There are not less than two hundred ^{*aircraft*} float ships
8 situated on Lake Hood, near Anchorage, Alaska, and

9 WHEREAS, it is in the interests of safety that a short
10 access road be constructed from the East side of Lake Hood around
11 the North shore to the West side thereof, and

12 WHEREAS, At certain times of the year Lake Hood and Lake
13 Spenard are low and dangerous to air traffic, and

14 WHEREAS, A short taxiway is needed connecting the West side
15 of Lake Hood with International Airport, and

16 WHEREAS, A pull out ramp is badly needed on Lake Hood for
17 itinerant traffic,

18 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives
19 that the Board of Aeronautics and the Director thereof be and
20 they are hereby directed as follows:

21 1. To construct a road linking the East and West sides of
22 Lake Hood by way of the North shore.

23 2. To install a headgate at the East end of Lake Spenard
24 suitable to control water level.

25 3. To install a suitable pull out ramp on Lake Hood.

26 4. To construct a taxiway linking the West shore of Lake
27 Hood with International Airport.
