HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 8

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the natives of Beaver, Stevens Village and other villages along the Yukon and Kuskokwim Rivers are without medical attention, and

WHEREAS, the school teachers and others are inadequate to attend to their needs, and

WHEREAS, a public health nurse visiting these villages once a month would prevent much pain, suffering and disease;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that Dr. C. Earl Albrecht, Commissioner of Health, be and is hereby directed to assign one or more public health nurses to visit the villages without medical attention along the Yukon and Kuskokwim Rivers in the Fourth Division as often as practicable.
