TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, Basketball has become the game most played by the young men of the Territory and the game with the largest participation by both players and spectators; and

WHEREAS, in the recent All-Alaska High School championship game the Juneau High School Crimson Bears won the best two out of three series from the Anchorage High School Eagles; and

WHEREAS, this was probably the most exciting championship tilt of all time and was the first time that the visiting team has won the championship,
