6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 44-2-2 ACLA 1949,
7 to transfer responsibility for maintain-
8 ing veterans' records from the Office of
9 Auditor to the Registrar of Vital
10 Statistics."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. That Section 44-2-2, Alaska Compiled Laws Anno-
13 tated, 1949 be amended so as to read as follows:

14 Section 44-2-2. RECORD: VETERANS OF WORLD WAR I.
15 The Registrar of Vital Statistics [AUDITOR OF ALASKA]
16 shall compile a correct record of all persons who were
17 bona fide residents of the Territory of Alaska and who
18 actively served in the U.S. Army, Navy or Marine Corps
19 between April 6, 1917 and November 11, 1918, such records
20 to be kept on file at the office of the Registrar of Vital
21 Statistics [AUDITOR OF ALASKA] and shall be available and
22 open to the inspection of anyone desiring to inspect the
23 same. Such record shall contain the name, age and place
24 of residence at the time of entering service, place and
25 date of commission, enlistment or induction, branch of
26 service, record of service and the date, place and nature
27 of discharge.

23 Sec. 2. Upon the effective date of this Act the records
27 defined in Section 44-2-2, Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated, 1949

1 and all more recent records of a similar nature from Selective
2 Service or other sources, now located in the Office of Auditor,
3 shall be transferred to the custody of the Registrar of Vital
4 Statistics.
