12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 124, Session Laws of
14 Alaska 1951 as amended by Sections 1 and 2, Chapter 59, Session
15 Laws of Alaska, 1953, is amended by adding subsection (22) to
16 read as follows:

17 (22) "Special mobile equipment" shall be taken to
18 mean and include every vehicle not designed or used pri-
19 marily for the transportation of persons or property and
20 incidentally operated or moved over a highway, including
21 farm tractors, road construction or maintenance machinery,
22 ditch-digging apparatus, well-boring apparatus, and concrete
23 mixers. The foregoing enumeration shall be deemed partial
24 and shall not operate to exclude other such vehicles which
25 are within the general terms of this section.

26 Sec. 2. Section 3 (1) of Chapter 124, Session Laws of
27 Alaska, 1951, is amended to read as follows:

28 (1) VEHICLES SUBJECT TO REGISTRATION -- EXCEPTION.

29 Every motor vehicle, trailer and semi-trailer when driven
30 or moved upon a highway shall be subject to the registra-

tion provisions of this act except:

(a) Any such vehicle which is driven or moved upon a highway only for the purpose of crossing such highway from one property to another.

(b) Any implement of husbandry which is only incidentally operated or moved upon a highway.

(c) Any special mobile equipment.

Sec. 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
