6 For an Act entitled: "An act amending Section 47-2-1 ACLA 1949
7 relating to adverse possession against
8 the Territory ^{and} ~~and~~ ^{delete} declaring an emer-
9 gency."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. That Section 47-2-1 ACLA 1949 be amended by
12 adding a new paragraph, to read as follows:

13 No prescription or statute of limitations shall run, or
14 continue to run, against the title of interest of the Terri-
15 tory of Alaska to lands under the jurisdiction of the Terri-
16 tory; and no title or interest to any such lands of the
17 Territory of Alaska or any right therein shall be acquired
18 by adverse possession or prescription, or otherwise than by
19 conveyance from the Territory of Alaska.

20 Sec. 2. An emergency ^{delete} is hereby declared to exist ~~and~~ this
21 act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
