5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 65-5-32 ACIA 1949,
7 relating to the crime of burglary not in a
8 dwelling house."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 65-5-32 ACIA 1949 is hereby amended to read as
11 follows:

12 Section 65-5-32. Burglary not in dwelling house. That
13 if any person shall [/] BREAK AND [/] enter any building within the
14 curtilage of any dwelling house, but not forming a part thereof,
15 or shall [/] BREAK AND [/] enter any building whatever or part
16 thereof, or shall enter any boat, vehicle or other conveyance,
17 [/] BOOTH, TENT, RAILWAY CAR, VESSEL, BOAT, OR OTHER STRUCTURE OR
18 ERECTION [/] in which property is kept, with intent to steal
19 therein or to commit any felony therein, such person shall be
20 deemed guilty of burglary, and upon conviction thereof shall be
21 punished by imprisonment in the penitentiary not less than two
22 nor more than five years.
