7 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to meetings of the
8 Territorial Board of Education; amending
9 Section 37-2-5 ACLA 1949 as previously
10 amended by Chapter 34 SLA 1951 and
11 Chapter 55 SLA 1953; and establishing an
12 effective date."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

14 Section 1. Section 37-2-5 ACLA 1949 as previously amended
15 by Chapter 34 SLA 1951 and Chapter 55 SLA 1953, is hereby
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 37-2-5. MEETINGS OF BOARD AND NOTICE THEREOF:

18 QUORUM: VOTING: Regular meetings of the Board of
19 Education shall be held each year. One such meeting shall
20 be held at the Capitol during regular sessions of the
21 Territorial Legislature. [ALL] The other regular meeting
22 [is] in each biennium shall be held at such time and place
23 in the Territory as may be designated by the Board; pro-
24 vided, that special meetings shall be called by the
25 Commissioner of Education at the written request of a majority
26 of the members of the Board, or may be called by the Governor
27 on his own initiative, at such places in the Territory as
28 may be designated in the call for the special meeting.
29 Written or telegraphic notice of all regular and special
30 meetings of the Board of Education shall be given to each

member thereof at his last known address at least fifteen (15) days prior to the date of such meeting. The regular meetings of the Board shall last not to exceed fifteen (15) days, and a special meeting shall last not to exceed five (5) days. Three (3) members shall constitute a quorum but a less number may adjourn from day to day for a period not exceeding ten (10) days; provided, however, that no action may be taken or resolution or motion adopted by the Board unless at least three (3) affirmative votes are in favor thereof.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval according to law.
