6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to school holidays;
7 amending Section 37-1-7 ACLA 1949, and
8 ~~declaring an effective date.~~

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Section 37-1-7 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to
11 read as follows:

12 Section 37-1-7. SCHOOL HOLIDAYS. No teacher shall be
13 required to teach school on Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and
14 the day immediately following Thanksgiving Day, Christmas,
15 New Years, Memorial Day and the Fourth of July, nor shall
16 the monthly salary of any teacher be diminished because of
17 the fact that these holidays fall on a school day. If any
18 one of these holidays shall fall on a Saturday, the Friday
19 immediately preceding shall be considered a school holiday.
20 If any one of these holidays shall fall on a Sunday the
21 Monday immediately following shall be considered a school
22 holiday. The public schools shall be in session on all
23 other legal holidays falling upon school days and shall give
24 appropriate exercises in commemoration of the day; Provided,
25 that the school board may declare a holiday when good reason
26 exists therefor.

27 Section 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage and
28 approval according to law.
