6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 65-10-3 ACLA 1949,
7 relating to the crime of disorderly con-
8 duct."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 65-10-3 ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as
11 follows:

12 Section 65-10-3. Disorderly conduct: Disturbance of
13 the Peace. If any person or persons shall use any obscene or
14 profane language in any public place or private house or place
15 to the disturbance or annoyance of any person or persons, or
16 shall make any loud noise or be guilty of tumultuous conduct in
17 any public place or private house to the disturbance or annoyance
18 of any person or persons, or be otherwise guilty of disorderly
19 conduct to the disturbance or annoyance of any person or persons,
20 or shall be drunk in any private house or place to the annoyance
21 of any person or persons, or shall be drunk in or upon any boat,
22 train, passenger coach, airplane, or other vehicle commonly used
23 for the transportation of passengers or in or about any depot,
24 platform, wharf or waiting room, or upon any public street, or at
25 any public gathering, or in any hotel lobby, store, card room,
26 dance hall, theatre, liquor dispensary, or any other public place,
27 or shall drink intoxicating liquor in or about any depot, plat-
28 form, wharf or waiting room, or upon any public street, or at
29 any public gathering, or any hotel lobby, dance hall, theatre,

or any other public place not permitted under license to dispense
intoxicating liquor, such person or persons shall, upon con-
viction thereof, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be
punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars
(\$300.00) or by imprisonment in the jail for not more than six (6)
months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
