6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to vocational rehabili-
7 tation; amending Sections 37-9-5 and
8 37-9-6, ACIA, 1949."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Section 37-9-5, Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated,
11 1949, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

12 Sec. 37-9-5, REHABILITATION OF DISABLED PERSONS:

13 FEDERAL AID ACCEPTED: COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL ACTS. The
14 Territory of Alaska hereby accepts the provisions of the
15 Act of Congress approved June 2, 1920, entitled: "An Act
16 to provide for the promotion of vocational rehabilitation
17 of persons disabled in industry or otherwise and their
18 return to productive employment," as amended, and as may
19 be subsequently amended, (BY PUBLIC LAW 113 -- of 78 CONGRESS
20 (29 USC SECTIONS 31-41 HEREIN),) and will observe and
21 comply with all of the provisions of such Acts.

22 Section 2. Section 37-9-6, Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated,
23 1949, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

24 Sec. 37-9-6. AUTHORITY FOR FEDERAL COOPERATION: BOARD
25 OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION: POWERS. The Territorial Board
26 of Education which is hereby constituted the Ex Officio
27 Board of Vocational Education is hereby authorized and
28 empowered to cooperate with any Federal Agency, as pro-
29 vided and required by the aforesaid Act of Congress, and

with the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation, Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, or its successor, (FEDERAL SECURITY AGENCY) in the administering of the provisions of said Act, and to do all of the things necessary to entitle the Territory to receive the benefits thereof. Said Board is further empowered to do all acts and things and to make such plans, rules and regulations as are necessary to properly carry out the provisions of the aforesaid Act and the purposes of this Act. Said Board shall have the authority to appoint such administrative officers as are required to carry out the provisions of this Act (, AND THE ACT OF CONGRESS HEREIN DESCRIBED).
