TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An act to amend Section 37-4-1 ACLA 1949,
pertaining to school taxes."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 37-4-1 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended so as
to read as follows:

Sec. 37-4-1. Tax imposed: Persons subject to tax:
Amount: Payment. There is hereby imposed upon all male
persons and all female persons, except those who are unem-
ployed and whose support is entirely dependent upon the
income of their husbands and whose husband has paid a school
tax for the current year, in this Territory or the waters,
thereof, over twenty-one and under ~~thirty-five~~ ^{thirty-four} ~~years~~
years of age, except those mentioned in the next following
section, a school tax of ~~\$5.00~~ ^{\$7.50} ~~per year~~; all persons
subject to said tax shall pay the same, upon demand, to the
school tax collector between the first day of January and the
first day of December of each year. Any person subject to
said tax who shall fail or neglect to pay the same when de-
mand for payment thereof is made, or if the school tax col-
lector fails to demand or collect the same during that time,
shall pay such tax at any time during that year to the school
tax collector of the district in which he may be or to the
Tax Commissioner at Juneau.
