SENATE BILL NO. 116

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting a person who kills another person from inheriting or otherwise obtaining or receiving property from the decedent; amending Title 61, Chapter 18, ACLA 1949 by adding a new Section 61-18-8; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Title 61, Chapter 18, ACLA 1949 is hereby amended by adding a new Section 61-18-8 to read as follows:

Section 61-18-8. Person who kills decedent denied distributive share. Any person who is or shall hereafter be convicted of killing or of conspiring with another to kill, or of procuring to be killed, any other person from whom such person so killing or conspiring to kill or procuring said killing would inherit or otherwise receive, secure or obtain property, real, personal, or mixed, or any part thereof, belonging to such deceased person at the time of death, or who would take said property by deed, will, contract, or otherwise at the death of the deceased, shall be denied all right, interest and estate in or to said property or any part thereof, and the same shall descend and be distributed to such other person or persons as may be entitled thereto by the laws of descent and distribution, as if the person so convicted were dead.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
