6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing school boards to
7 declare a board vacancy when a member
8 thereof is absent from three consecutive
9 meetings without prior excuse; amending
10 Title 37, Chapter 2, Article 4 thereof,
11 ACLA 1949, by adding a new section
12 37-2-57."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

14 Section 1. That Title 37, Chapter 2, Article 4 thereof,
15 ACLA 1949, is amended by adding a new section, 37-2-57, to read
16 as follows:

17 Sec. 37-2-57. DECLARING A BOARD VACANCY. When a member
18 of a school board of an incorporated, independent, or city
19 school district, having been duly notified of the regular
20 meeting of the board, shall be absent from three (3)
21 consecutive regular meetings without having been granted
22 prior excuse by the President of the board, the other members
23 of the board may, in their discretion, declare the position
24 vacant and shall so notify the ex-member by registered mail;
25 Provided, that the vacancy shall then be filled as otherwise
26 provided in the law for the several types of school
27 districts.
