TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to aid to dependent children; increasing the maximum benefits therefor; amending Sec. 51-2-33 ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 57 SLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 106 SLA 1951; and fixing an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 51-2-33 ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 57 SLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 106 SLA 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 51-2-33. AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE. The amount of assistance which shall be granted for any dependent child, and the relative with whom the dependent child is living, shall be determined by the Welfare Department with due regard to the resources and necessary expenditures of the family and the condition existing in each case and shall be sufficient, when added to all other income and support available to the child, to provide such child and relative with reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health; provided, however, that the amount of assistance granted shall not exceed ~~SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00)~~ eighty dollars (\$80.00) where there is a relative and one child, and where there is more than one such child, the amount allowed for the relative and first child shall not

2 exceed SIXTY DOLLARS (\$60.00) eighty dollars (\$80.00)
3 and the amount for each additional child shall not exceed
4 thirty dollars (\$30.00).

5 Section 2. The effective date of this Act shall be April
