SENATE BILL NO. 129

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing hours of work for Territorial employees; authorizing such employees to work part-time with other Territorial offices; providing for compensatory leave; repealing and reenacting Section 11-5-3 ACLA 1949."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 11-5-3 ACLA 1949, is repealed, and a new Section 11-5-3, in lieu thereof, is enacted to read as follows:

Section 11-5-3. HOURS OF WORK; PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT; COMPENSATORY LEAVE.

(a) The hours of work for Territorial office employees shall be from 9:00 A.M. until 12:00 Noon and from 1:00 P.M. until 5:00 P.M. daily except on Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays; provided, however, that each agency-head must:

(1) assign at least one employee to open the agency office for the accommodation of the public from 9:00 A.M. until 12:00 Noon on Saturdays; (2) rotate the Saturday assignments fairly among the employees; and (3) business permitting, relieve the other employees from reporting for duty on Saturdays.

(b) Territorial employees are hereby permitted during non-duty hours to be employed on a part-time basis by offices of the Territory other than the one for which regularly

employed.

(c) The department heads of Territorial agencies may require employees to work in excess of the regular hours of employment; provided, however, that such employees at such time or times as the agency head deems expedient, shall be granted compensatory leave for such overtime; provided that employees assigned to duty on Saturday morning shall not be granted compensatory time for hours worked on said morning.
