IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

THIRTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the University of

Alaska to issue bonds and incur indebtedness; amending Section 37-10-6, ACIA, 1949, by adding a new paragraph; declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 37-10-6, ACIA, 1949, is hereby amended to include the following paragraphs:

Section 37-10-6. Powers and duties of Board of Regents. The Board of Regents shall have full power and authority to determine the time and place of meeting and the manner of notifying its members to convene at such meeting, and also to elect by a majority vote of the whole Board, an executive head of the said University who may attend all meetings of the Board. The said Board shall establish this position and fix the salary and emoluments of the executive head of the University, all heads of departments, professors, teachers, instructors, and other officers; and the said Board is further empowered to make or ordain, as the occasion may require, reasonable rules, orders and plans not in conflict with the Constitution of the United States and the laws of the Territory with reasonable penalties, for the good government of the said corporation, for the regulation of their own body, and also by and with the advice of the executive

1 head of the University to determine and regulate the course
2 of instruction in said University; but no instruction either
3 sectarian in religion or partisan in politics, shall ever be
4 permitted in any department of the University; and no sec-
5 tarian or partisan test shall be allowed or exercised in the
6 appointment of Regents or in the appointment of any instruc-
7 tors or other officers of the University or in the admission
8 of students thereto or for any purpose whatever. The Board
9 of Regents shall confer such appropriate degrees as they may
10 determine and prescribe. The Regents shall have the care,
11 control and management of all the real and personal property
12 and all moneys of the said University and shall keep a
13 correct and easily understood record of the minutes of every
14 meeting and all acts done by them in pursuance of their
15 duties, and shall cause to be kept a complete record of all
16 moneys received and disbursements thereof. They shall make
17 a written report to the Legislature at the beginning of its
18 regular sessions of the condition of the University property,
19 of all receipts and expenditures and of the educational and
20 other work performed, provided, nevertheless, that no cor-
21 porate business shall be transacted at any meeting unless at
22 least five of the Regents are present, the majority of the
23 whole Board to approve the same.

24 The Board of Regents is authorized to issue bonds or
25 incur such bonded indebtedness as may be necessary for the
26 acquisition or installation of any building or buildings and
27 facilities connected therewith at the University of Alaska;
28 provided, however, such indebtedness or encumbrance shall be
29 a charge solely against said building or buildings and

1 facilities so acquired or installed and/or such revenues as
2 are derived from income producing activities of the Univer-
3 sity of Alaska.

4 Section 2. An emergency is declared to exist and this Act
5 shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
