IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to require employees of the Territorial Government to resign from their position before filing as a candidate for an elective office."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. No full-time employee of the Territory of Alaska in either an elective or appointive position shall, while so employed by said Territory, file, or be eligible to file, for an elective office subject to Territorial election without first resigning from the full-time position held; Provided, however, that an elective officer may, without first resigning, file for reelection to the elective position by him held.

Sec. 2. Any officer or employee of this Territory who pays out of any public funds or fees under his control or who draws or authorizes the drawing of any warrant or authority for the payment out of any public funds or fees of the salary, pay or compensation of any person violating the provisions of Section 1 hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of twice the amount so paid from public funds, not to exceed one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars.
