4 TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing Legislative Districts
7 for the election of members of the Terri-
8 torial House of Representatives."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. The Legislature of the Territory of Alaska,
11 acting under and by virtue of the power and authority granted
12 in the Organic Act, do hereby establish the districts from
13 which the members of the House of Representatives of the Terri-
14 tory of Alaska shall be elected, in accordance with the number
15 of inhabitants, as herein set forth.

16 Section 2. The House of Representatives shall consist of
17 twenty-four members who shall be elected from twenty-four
18 representative districts herein established, and said repre-
19 sentative districts are hereby created, constituted and numbered
20 as follows:

21 FIRST JUDICIAL DIVISION

22 District No. 1. Ketchikan town.

23 District No. 2. Ketchikan Recording District

24 outside of Ketchikan town, *Hyder*
Recording District.

25 District No. 3. Wrangell, ~~Hyder~~ and Petersburg

26 Recording Districts.

27 District No. 4. Sitka Recording District.

28 District No. 5. Juneau city.

29 District No. 6. Juneau Recording District.

SECOND JUDICIAL DIVISION

District No. 1. Noatak-Kobuk and Fairhaven
Recording Districts.

District No. 2. That portion of Cape Nome Re-
cording District lying north of
64° N. latitude, plus the Koyuk
Recording District.

District No. 3. That portion of the Cape Nome
Recording District lying south
of 64° N. latitude, plus Wade
Hampton Recording District.

THIRD JUDICIAL DIVISION

District No. 1. Kodiak, Aleutian Islands and
Unga Peninsula Recording Dis-
tricts.

District No. 2. Homer, Seldovia, Kvichak, Illiamna
and Bristol Bay Recording Dis-
tricts.

District No. 3. Cordova, McCarthy, Valdez,
Chitina, Talkeetna and Wasilla
Recording Districts, and that
portion of the Palmer Recording
District lying east of 149° W.
longitude.

District No. 4. Seward and Whittier Recording
Districts, that portion of
Anchorage Recording District

lying south of 61° N. latitude,
and that portion of Anchorage
Recording District lying west
of $150^{\circ} 5'$ W. longitude.

District No. 5. That portion of Palmer Recording
District lying west of 149° W.
longitude and that portion of
Anchorage Recording District
lying north of $61^{\circ} 14'$ N. lati-
tude and east of $150^{\circ} 5'$ W. longi-
tude.

District No. 6. That portion of Anchorage Re-
cording District east of $150^{\circ} 5'$
W. longitude which lies south of
 $61^{\circ} 14'$ N. latitude and north of
 $61^{\circ} 13'$ N. latitude, but not
including any part of Anchorage
city.

District No. 7. That portion of Anchorage Re-
cording District east of $150^{\circ} 5'$
W. longitude which lies north of
 61° N. latitude and south of 61°
 $11'$ N. latitude.

District No. 8. That portion of Anchorage Re-
cording District east of $150^{\circ} 5'$
W. longitude which lies north of
 $61^{\circ} 11'$ N. latitude and south of
 $61^{\circ} 13'$ N. latitude but not in-
cluding any part of Anchorage

city.

Districts Nos. 9 & 10. Anchorage city. (Two

members to be elected at large ~~within the city~~)

FOURTH JUDICIAL DIVISION

District No. 1. Bethel and Kuskokwim Recording Districts.

District No. 2. Mount McKinley, Innoko, Otter, Kulato, Nenana, Fort Gibbon, Hot Springs, ~~Televens~~, Rampart, Koyukuk, Circle, and Eagle Recording Districts, that portion of Fairbanks Recording District lying north of 66° N. latitude and that portion of Fairbanks Recording District lying west of $149^{\circ} 30'$ W. longitude.

District No. 3. Fairbanks city.

District No. 4. That portion of Fairbanks Recording District lying east of $147^{\circ} 50'$ W. longitude, west of $147^{\circ} 35'$ W. longitude, south of $64^{\circ} 55'$ N. latitude and north of $64^{\circ} 45'$ N. latitude but not including any part of Fairbanks city.

District No. 5. That portion of Fairbanks Recording District lying west of $147^{\circ} 50'$ W. longitude, east of $147^{\circ} 35'$ W. longitude, north of

64° 55' N. latitude and south
of 64° 45' N. latitude, but
excepting that portion of Fair-
banks Recording District lying
north of 66° N. latitude and
that portion lying west of
148° 30' W. longitude.

Section 3. The representatives provided for in this Act
shall be elected at the general election to be held on the
second Tuesday in October, 1956 and every two years thereafter.

Section 4. All Acts and parts of Acts in conflict here-
with are hereby repealed.
