2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

5 WHEREAS, Divine Providence in its inscrutable way did seem  
6 fit to call Senator A. F. (Joe) Coble to eternal rest at a time  
7 when he was a member of this Body and as such had endeared him-  
8 self in the hearts of his colleagues and earned their respect  
9 and confidence in the fullest degree by his indefatigable  
10 industry,

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of  
12 Representatives concurring, that the members of the Twenty-  
13 second Legislative Assembly, appreciating the <sup>grievous</sup> loss they  
14 and the other residents of this Territory have sustained in the  
15 passing of Senator A. F. (Joe) Coble, hereby give expression  
16 to their highest esteem for the deceased and, in recognition  
17 of his record of service to his Territory, resolve that Saturday,  
18 the <sup>Coble</sup> fourth day of February, 1955, be set aside in memory of  
19 their former colleague and that both Houses adjourn at noon of  
20 that day.

22 upon the Journals of both Houses and a copy thereof forwarded to  
23 the widow and other members of the family of deceased.
