IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

6 WHEREAS, Divine Providence, in its inscrutable way did seem ^{and}
0 fit to call Senator John F. Gorsuch to eternal rest at a time
4 when he was a member of this Body and as such had endeared him-
8 self in the hearts of his colleagues and earned their respect
2 and confidence in the fullest degree by his indefatigable
6 industry.

10 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of
14 Representatives concurring, that the members of the Twenty-
18 second Legislative Assembly, appreciating the ^{great} ^{loss}
22 they and the other residents of this Territory have sustained
26 in the passing of Senator John F. Gorsuch, hereby give expres-
30 sion to their highest esteem for the deceased and, in recogni-
34 tion of his record of service to his Territory, resolve that
38 Saturday, the ^{fourth} day of February, 1955, be set aside in
42 memory of their former colleague and that both Houses adjourn
46 at noon of that day.
