8 wooden structures and their contents situated at Sitka and Goddard  
9 Hot Springs, Alaska, are obsolete and of no use to the Territory,  
10 now therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Alaska  
12 Pioneers' Home is hereby authorized to deal with said property  
13 as it, in its sound judgment, may deem the most advantageous to  
14 the Territory.
