5 TO THE HONORABLE E. L. BARTLETT, DELEGATE TO CONGRESS FROM
6 ALASKA: AND TO THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES:

7 Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of
8 Alaska respectfully represents:

9 WHEREAS, Alaska has potential opportunities for great
10 future industrial development; and

11 WHEREAS, many and suitable sites needed for these industrial
12 plants, mills and related use, etc., are owned by the United
13 States Government; and

14 WHEREAS, under present law the General Land Office does not
15 have authority to make over 160 acres available for patent; and

16 WHEREAS, some of the sites needed are in excess of 160
17 acres;

18 NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the
19 Territory of Alaska, respectfully prays that Congress immediately
20 authorize sale by the General Land Office, of sites in excess of
21 160 acres in cases where it can be shown that larger sites are
22 needed for industrial plants, mills and related uses. The
23 patent should provide that the land would revert to its former
24 status unless used for the purpose intended within a reasonable
25 period of time.
