2 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 1

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

6 WHEREAS, The Employment Security Commission fund is critical-  
7 ly low, and

8 WHEREAS, unemployment benefits may be curtailed to the  
9 detriment of the recipients of unemployment compensation, who  
10 are unemployed through no fault of their own, at a time when they  
11 need compensation most; and

12 WHEREAS, the expenditures of unemployment compensation  
13 benefits by the recipients bolsters the economy and stability  
14 of many businesses and in effect insures the continuance of many  
15 such businesses; and

16 WHEREAS, Congress has made provision to loan money without  
17 interest to such Employment Security Commission Funds that have  
18 become inadequate to meet local, State and Territorial needs; and

19 WHEREAS, such States and Territories have as long as four  
20 years to repay such interest-free loans to the Federal Government;

21 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Territory  
22 of Alaska, in Twenty-Second Session assembled at Juneau, Alaska,  
23 that said Senate requests the Honorable B. Frank Heintzleman,  
24 Governor of Alaska, to make immediate application for a sufficient  
25 loan to maintain the solvency of the Alaska Employment Security  
26 Program at its present level.
