2 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 2

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-SECOND SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ALASKA LEGISLATURE:

6 WHEREAS, Our Heavenly Father on November 29, 1954 saw fit  
7 to relieve our esteemed colleague, former Territorial Senator  
8 Edward Anderson <sup>of Nome, Alaska,</sup> of his earthly burdens; and

9 WHEREAS, the Honorable Edward Anderson, during his 48 years  
10 of residence in the Territory of Alaska, toiled unceasingly for  
11 progressive welfare of Alaska's citizens, and for the develop-  
12 ment of the Territory's natural resources; and

13 WHEREAS, the Honorable Edward Anderson admirably served the  
14 people of Alaska for several sessions in the House of Representa-  
15 tives and the Territorial Senate; and

16 WHEREAS, the outstanding sincere integrity of character  
17 exemplified by the late Honorable Edward Anderson prompted his  
18 constituents to keep sending him back to the Legislature for  
19 several sessions; and

20 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Edward Anderson was a kindly  
21 man of generous disposition; a man of great moral fortitude  
22 and intelligence;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Alaska  
24 Legislature in Twenty-Second Session assembled, that we mourn  
25 the passing of the Honorable Edward Anderson and desire, by  
26 this resolution, to convey our sympathy to his bereaved family;

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when the Senate adjourns on  
29 this, the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1955, it shall do so in honor
