2 SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 3

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-SECOND SESSION.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

6 WHEREAS, the workmen's compensation benefits must be main-
7 tained at a level to insure adequate medical attention and care of
8 workmen injured through no fault of their own; and

9 WHEREAS, the cost of workmen's compensation insurance in
10 Alaska is much greater than in any other jurisdiction under the
11 American flag; and

12 WHEREAS, the present law needs attention, study and over-
13 hauling to make it applicable to Alaska's needs;

14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Territory
15 of Alaska, in Twenty-second Regular Session assembled: that the
16 Legislative Council make thorough study of the workmen's compensa-
17 tion law and possible methods of financing adequate benefits at
18 reasonable cost, and report thereon to the Twenty-third Legis-
19 lature.
